This year they were nominated for the Corporate Leadership Award by the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank. Under the leadership of Aultman's President & CEO Ed Roth and Akron Children's Hospital's CEO Bill Considine, the Foodbank's Harvest for Hunger campaign exceeded goals in both 2011 and 2012 by raising more than \$1.8 million. Including a corporate-sponsored matching gift, Aultman's employees collected \$36,000 and 7,774 pounds of food in 2011 and \$43,285 and 10,968 pounds in 2012. Over the past seven years, Aultman and its employees have donated more than \$110,000 and hundreds of hours of volunteer service to the Foodbank.

Aultman's corporate commitment to give back to the communities where their employees live and work is exemplary. Their leadership demonstrates philanthropic concern and supports workplace volunteerism, which has improved the quality of life in our community and made an immediate impact on the lives of many individuals and families.
