The Women's Board of Aultman Hospital



Founded in 1969, the Women's Board of Aultman Hospital has spent the past 48 years remaining passionately true to their mission: supporting Aultman Hospital through community engagement and fundraising. Because of this dedication, \$25 million has been raised for Aultman Hospital and has led to enhanced patient care and services for many departments, including Pediatric Services, Emergency/ Trauma Center, NICU and most recently the Aultman Cancer Center.

The majority of those funds were raised as a result of the annual Women's Board Angel Auction, which has generated a total of almost \$14 million since 1970. Alongside the Angel Auction, the Women's Board manages several ongoing programs that generate revenue while providing valuable services, including an annual Fashion Show, Newborn Photos, The Shoppes at Aultman and Tribute Fund.

At 300 members strong today, the Women's Board is providing lasting community impact with efforts that go beyond fundraising. In 1980, the Women's Board initiated free health programs for the community, featuring local health care professionals discussing topics that promote wellness and inform the community about new developments in health care.

Through the years, the Women's Board has also provided talent, treasure and collaboration to other local nonprofits, including Habitat for Humanity, Meals on Wheels of Stark and Wayne Counties, Harvest for Hunger, Canton Symphony, Alzheimer's Association and Direction Home Akron Canton, just to name a few.

The Women's Board of Aultman Hospital has played a critical role in the health and wellness of our community for many years and will, without doubt, continue for many more.
